3. Format

(1) Oral presentations

Scientific Paper Abstracts (≤ 300 words) are due August 15, 2008. The scientific committee will review the abstracts according to the theme and importance. The abstracts with creative viewpoints and important efficiency will be selected and published. The authors need to prepare a 15-minute presentation in the assigned session.

(2) Poster presentations:

Scientific Poster Abstracts (≤ 300 words) are due August 15, 2008. Poster presentations have some advantages over traditional scientific papers. It gives participants more time to discuss their researches. The poster is also an efficient way to perform the non-academic or applied work. The scientific committee will review the abstracts according to the theme and importance. The abstracts with creative and important viewpoints will be selected. The authors need to prepare a poster with A0 size (portrait).

4. Your abstract (both oral and poster) should follow these rules:

- File format: *.doc, *.rtf, or *.txt (please DO NOT send the *.pdf files), not exceed 10Mb
- File name: please name the file as “first author’s and second author’s first names-the first

4-6 words of the title”, for example, “Chang-The Natural Purification of Urban.doc” or “Jordan and Wang-Exploring the Ecological Benefits.txt”.

- Keywords: please list 3 to 5 keywords
- Abstract format: see the following
